### Why ask why?

1. Because asking why **deepens my understanding**.

- The question of **why** is found over **500** times in the Bible.
- Jesus asked over **230 questions** in the gospels.

*My son, if you accept my words and store up my commands within you, <sup>2</sup> turning your ear to wisdom and applying your heart to understanding—<sup>3</sup> indeed, if you call out for insight and cry aloud for understanding,<sup>4</sup> and if you look for it as for silver and search for it as for hidden treasure,<sup>5</sup> then you will understand the fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of God.*

**Proverbs 2:1-5 (NIV)**

2. Because asking why **reveals my motive**.

*All a person's ways seem pure to them, but motives are weighed by the Lord.*

**Proverbs 16:2 (NIV)**

*Our purpose is to please God, not people. He alone examines the motives of our hearts.*

**1 Thessalonians 2:4b (NLT)**

*When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralyzed man, "Son, your sins are forgiven." <sup>6</sup> Now some teachers of the law were sitting there, thinking to themselves, <sup>7</sup> "Why does this fellow talk like that? He's blaspheming! Who can forgive sins but God alone?" <sup>8</sup> Immediately Jesus knew in his spirit that this was what they were thinking in their hearts, and he said to them, "Why are you thinking these things?"*

3. Because asking why **clarifies my purpose**.
