 - ⇒ 1 Peter 4:12-19

- 2. To test my faith.
 - ⇒ James 1:2-4
 - ⇒ Job!!!
- 3. A mixture of both!

Test are designed to...

1. Reveal – Show me the true depth of my faith.

⇒ My faith is to impact EVERY area of my life!

Search me, O God, and know my heart;

test me and know my anxious thoughts. Point out anything in me that offends you,

and lead me along the path of everlasting life.

⇒ Tests should <u>remind</u> me of the <u>goal</u>
